

Personal Riding Cart and Hoverboard Policy

Rutgers University Golf Course prohibits the use of privately owned motorized golf carts, golf hoverboards, electric scooters, golf motorcycles, and similar personal transportation devices on the golf course or practice facility.

The following exceptions are permitted:

- Remote-controlled electric push carts designed to transport golf bags, provided they are operated safely and do not carry a rider.
- Personal, single-rider adaptive golf carts or other mobility devices required by an individual with a disability. Golfers should contact the Golf Shop before arrival so staff can assist with access and course-condition requirements.

All permitted devices must remain out of restricted areas, including greens, tees, bunkers, environmentally sensitive areas, and locations designated by course staff. Their use may be limited during inclement weather or when course conditions could result in turf damage or create a safety concern.

Rutgers University Golf Course reserves the right to inspect any device, establish appropriate routes or operating restrictions, and discontinue its use if it is operated unsafely or causes damage. Golfers who bring an unauthorized device will be required to remove it from the property before beginning or continuing play.
