



Public Safety Escorts Available

Rutgers University Police Department provides escorts to students, faculty, and staff upon request. The escorts, primarily walking, provide our community with personalized service to their vehicles, campus residence, or the university's mass transit system. To request an escort, community members can call the Rutgers Police and the communications center will dispatch a public safety representative accordingly; escorts cannot be requested or "reserved" in advance.

Do it Right: Have Your Child's Car Seat Properly Installed

The National Highway Transportation Safety Administration (**NHTSA**) has determined motor vehicle crashes to be the number one cause of death of children over the age of six months in the United States. The proper use of child car seats is one of the simplest and most effective methods available for protecting the lives of our young children in the event of a motor vehicle crash. The Rutgers University Police Department, in partnership with the New Jersey Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has established a permanent Child Seat Inspection Station. Certified technicians assist in ensuring child safety seats are properly installed. The inspection station, located at 129 Davidson Road in Piscataway, is open Thursdays 3–7 p.m., and Saturdays 8 a.m.–noon.
